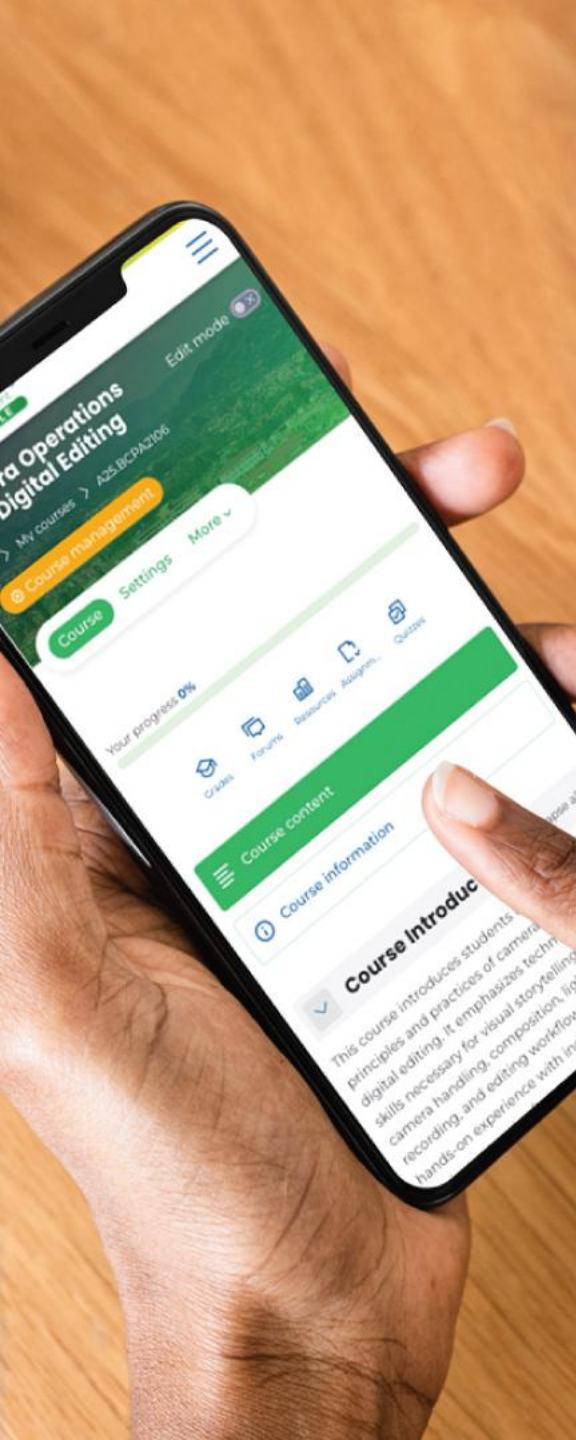

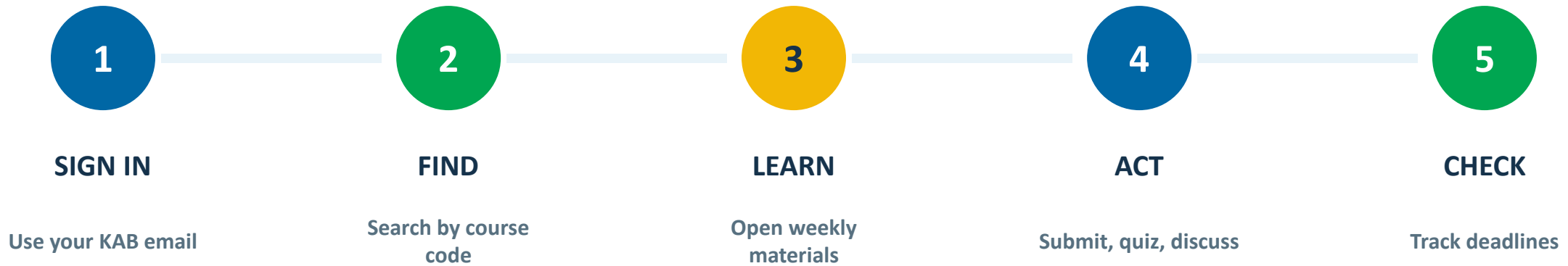
What is eLearning?

- For WIFI access, select **Eduroam**. It can be accessed using your KAB Email credentials.



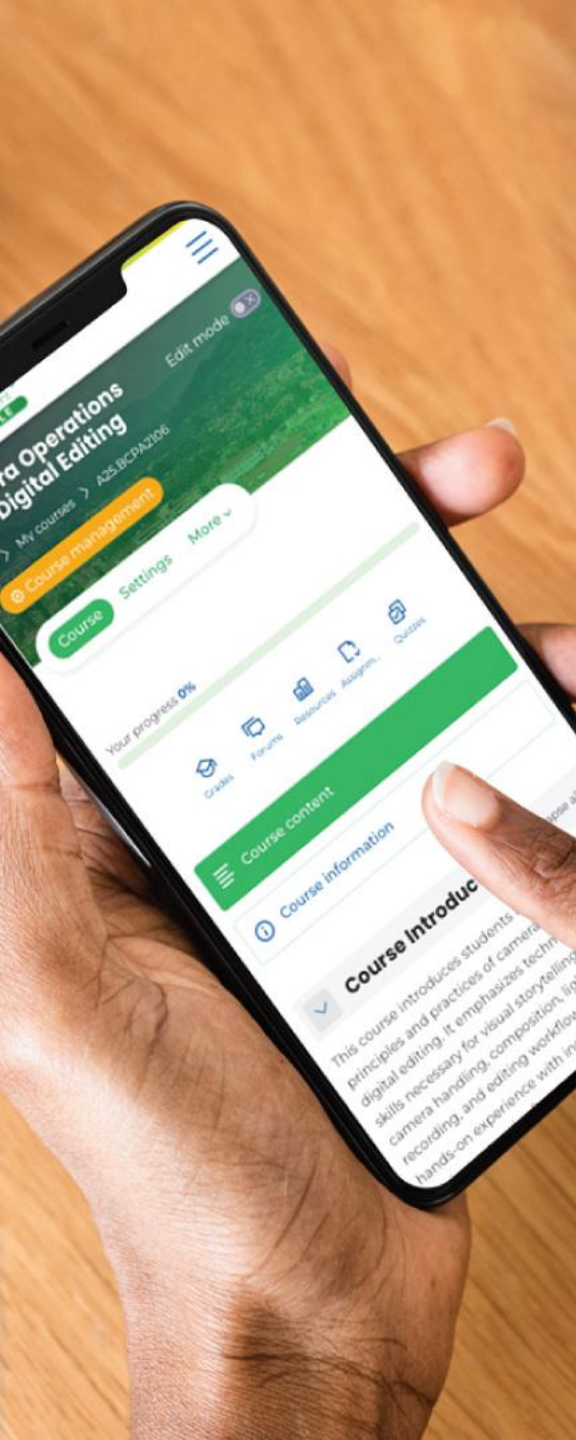
One simple journey: Enter, Learn, Act



Follow along on your phone or laptop. We will pause at each checkpoint.

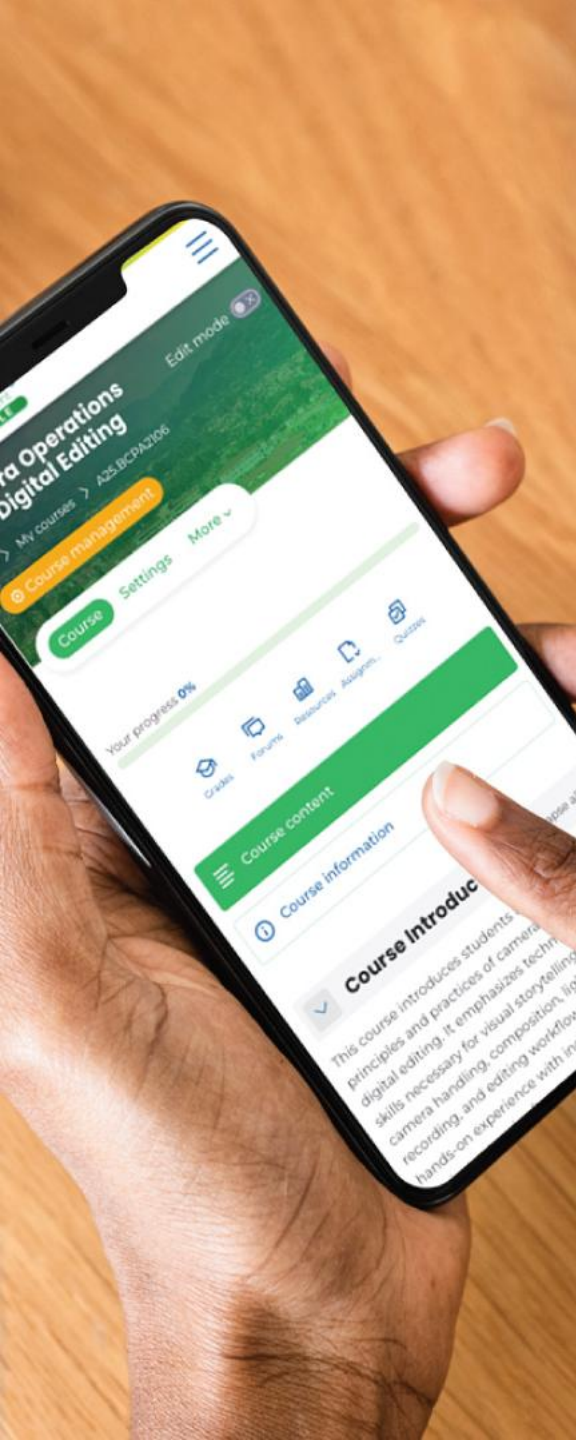

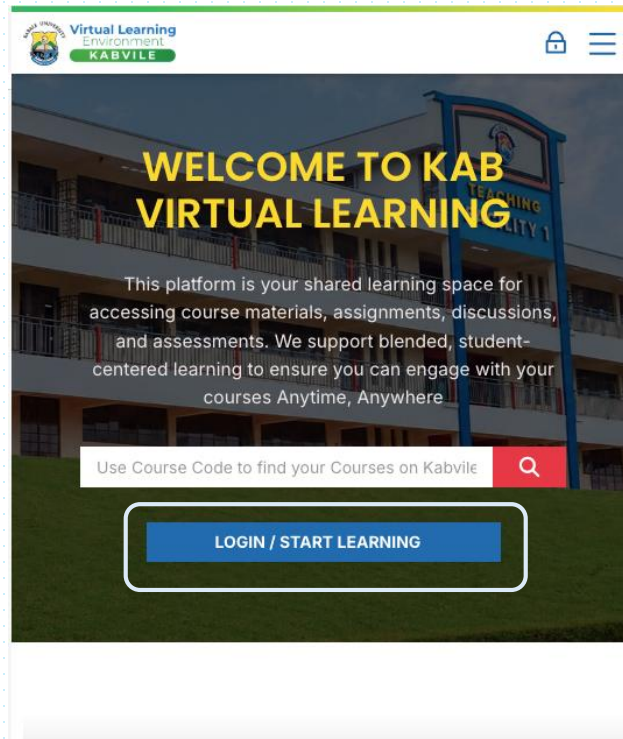
Creating your E-learning Account

- Go to **is.kab.ac.ug**
- Choose Sign in with KAB Email
- Tap or select **your KAB Email** on the next screen
- Scroll Down and Choose **Continue**
- Once you see the Dashboard, your **e-learning** and **Library Accounts** have been created
- Go to the Next Slide to Continue to E-learning

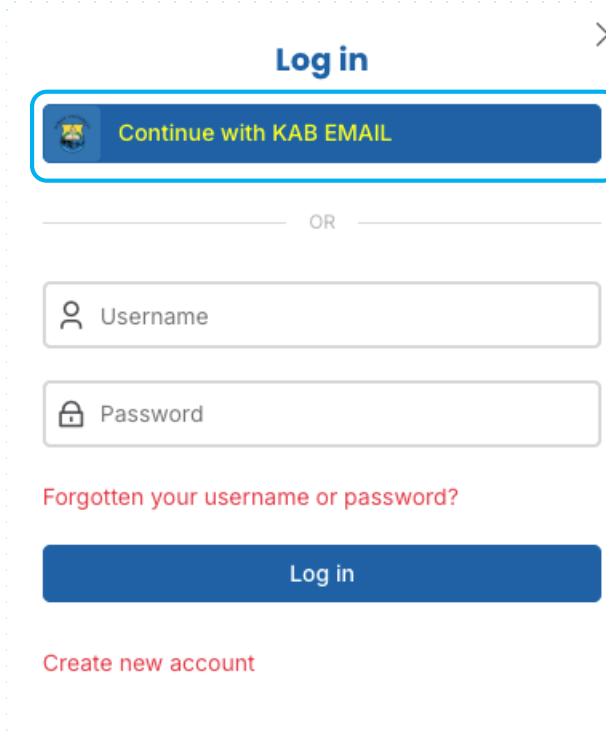
How to log in to KABVILE



Step 1. Browse to elearning.kab.ac.ug
Click the **Login/ Start Learning** button



Step 2. Click **Continue with KAB EMAIL**

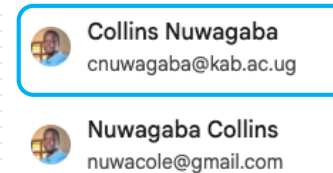


Step 3. Choose your KAB Email (if already logged-in on device) or **Use another account** and then enter your credentials

WHAT NEXT?



Timeline and calendar show upcoming work.

WHERE ARE MY COURSES?



My courses opens the units available to you.

WHAT CHANGED?



Notifications and messages keep you informed.

Checkpoint: point to My courses, Timeline and your profile menu on your own screen.



Read a course page from top to bottom

COURSE NAME • LECTURER • PROGRESS

-  **Announcements** Start here for updates
-  **Week or Topic** Follow the teaching sequence
-  **Materials** Open files, pages and videos
-  **Activities** Complete discussions, quizzes and assignments



Learn actively, even when data is limited

PREVIEW

Read the title and instructions before opening.

OPEN

Use the correct app or browser tab.

SAVE

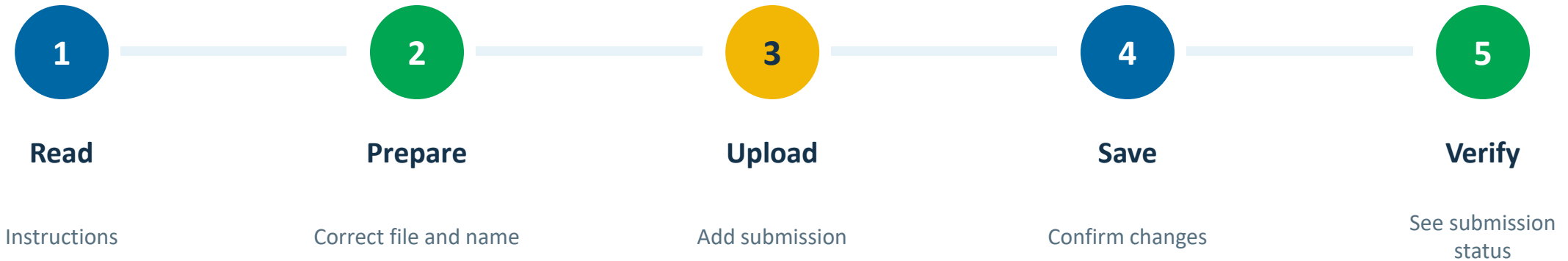
Download permitted files for offline study.

RETURN

Mark your place and come back for activities.

Good habit: rename downloaded files with the course code and topic.

Submit assignments before the deadline



Your submission is complete only when KABVILE shows the saved file and submission status. Keep your own copy.



A calm quiz starts before you click “Attempt”

BEFORE

Charge the device. Check time limit, attempts and closing time.

DURING

Read every question.
Save answers and watch the timer.

FINISH

Review unanswered items. Submit all and confirm completion.

If the connection fails, note the time and contact support promptly.

Participation is part of learning

ANNOUNCEMENTS

Read lecturer updates before asking what changed.

DISCUSSIONS

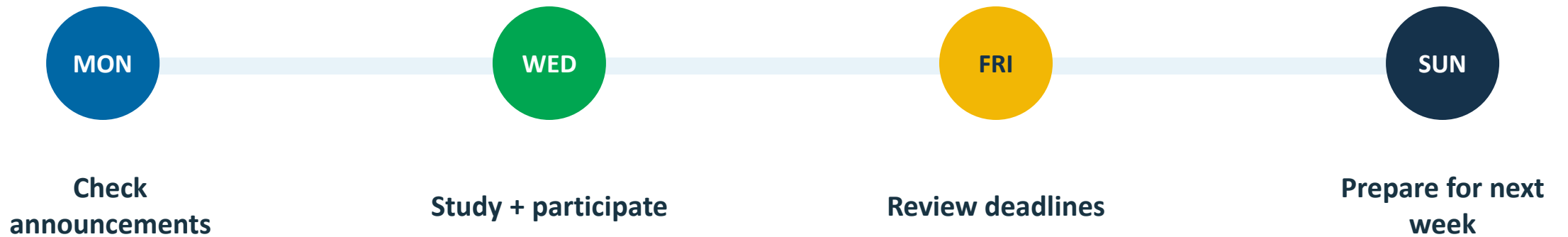
Post clearly, respond respectfully and stay on topic.

ONLINE CLASSES

Join early, mute when silent and use your real name.

Digital classroom rule: be clear, kind and academic.

Build a weekly KABVILE rhythm



Ten focused minutes checking your Timeline can prevent a missed deadline.

When something fails, use the right route

Cannot sign in



Course is missing



Upload will not finish



Still stuck

Check KAB email access → try Forgot password

Search by exact code → confirm allocation with lecturer

Check file type/size → reconnect → retry before deadline

Open a ticket at helpdesk.kab.ac.ug
